- ANY NUMBER of pieces may be submitted at 2:00 pm. One award per artist allowed.
- Display will be on YOUR EASEL

#### PLEIN AIR ART GUIDELINES

- 100% of each artwork must be created at or around the Museum the day of the judging
- ARTISTS may paint as many pictures as you choose but only one award will be given per person
- MEDIA may include oils, acrylics, watercolors, pastels, gouache, inks and/or pencils or graphite
- Artists NEW TO PLEIN AIR are encouraged

#### SALES

- SALES are allowed
- PAAC will retain a 35% commission on ALL sales of ALL paintings
- ALL SALES PAYMENTS must be made out to PAAC. Artists will be paid by August 31
- ALL ARTWORK should be tagged with artists name, telephone number and price (blank tags will be provided)
- ALL ARTWORK will be sold at the prices selected by the artist
- Artists may bring previously completed artwork to sell around your painting space. All sales go through PAAC (registration table) with 35% commission to PAAC.

#### PRIZES AND JUDGING

- JUDGES will be People attending "Art at the Museum" between Noon and 4 pm
- ONE VOTE per person will be allowed
- WINNERS will be announced and PRIZES awarded around 3:30 pm

#### AWARDS

• FOUR "PEOPLEs' CHOICE AWARDS" will at \$100 each and four Honorable Mention awards at \$50 will be given around 3:30 pm

#### ARTWORK PICKUP

• Please pick up your artwork and easel at 4 pm when the event closes
